

CRAIG ANDERSON'S GOALIE GEAR CONTEST

CONTEST RULES

1. The "CRAIG ANDERSON'S GOALIE GEAR CONTEST" is organized by Sher-Wood Hockey Inc.. The contest will take place on www.sher-wood.com from January 26, 2012 at 9:00 a.m. eastern standard time (EST) and will end on March 19, 2012 at 4:00 p.m. eastern standard time (EST).

ELIGIBILITY

2. The contest is open to all legal residents of Canada and United States who are thirteen (13) years of age or older at the time of registration. Excluded from the contest are: (1) people that are (during the contest period) employees, directors, officers, representatives and agents of Sher-Wood Hockey Inc. and people living at the same address (2) people who directly or indirectly participated in the design, management and/or distribution of this contest.

A) No purchase necessary. A purchase will not increase your chances of winning. Internet access required. PRIZE DESCRIPTION
